Austin – Bergstrom International Airport to Hotel:

From the airport, the minimum fare for taxi is \$12.85 this includes \$1.00 airport surcharge. The estimate cost of cab ride from airport is \$25-\$30. All taxis have a 4 passenger maximum.

From hotel to Norman Hackerman Building(meeting space):

The estimate cost of cab from hotel to meeting space is about \$10. The distance between the hotel and the meeting space is 2miles by cab (8min ride); walking, it is 1.5miles (roughly a 30min walk). The hotel has assured me that catching a cab outside their hotel would be no problem.












